The box will arrive back in the UK next summer (2009) having travelled the world. On its epic voyage it will see desert and ocean, sun and storms: all in a day's work for a container!



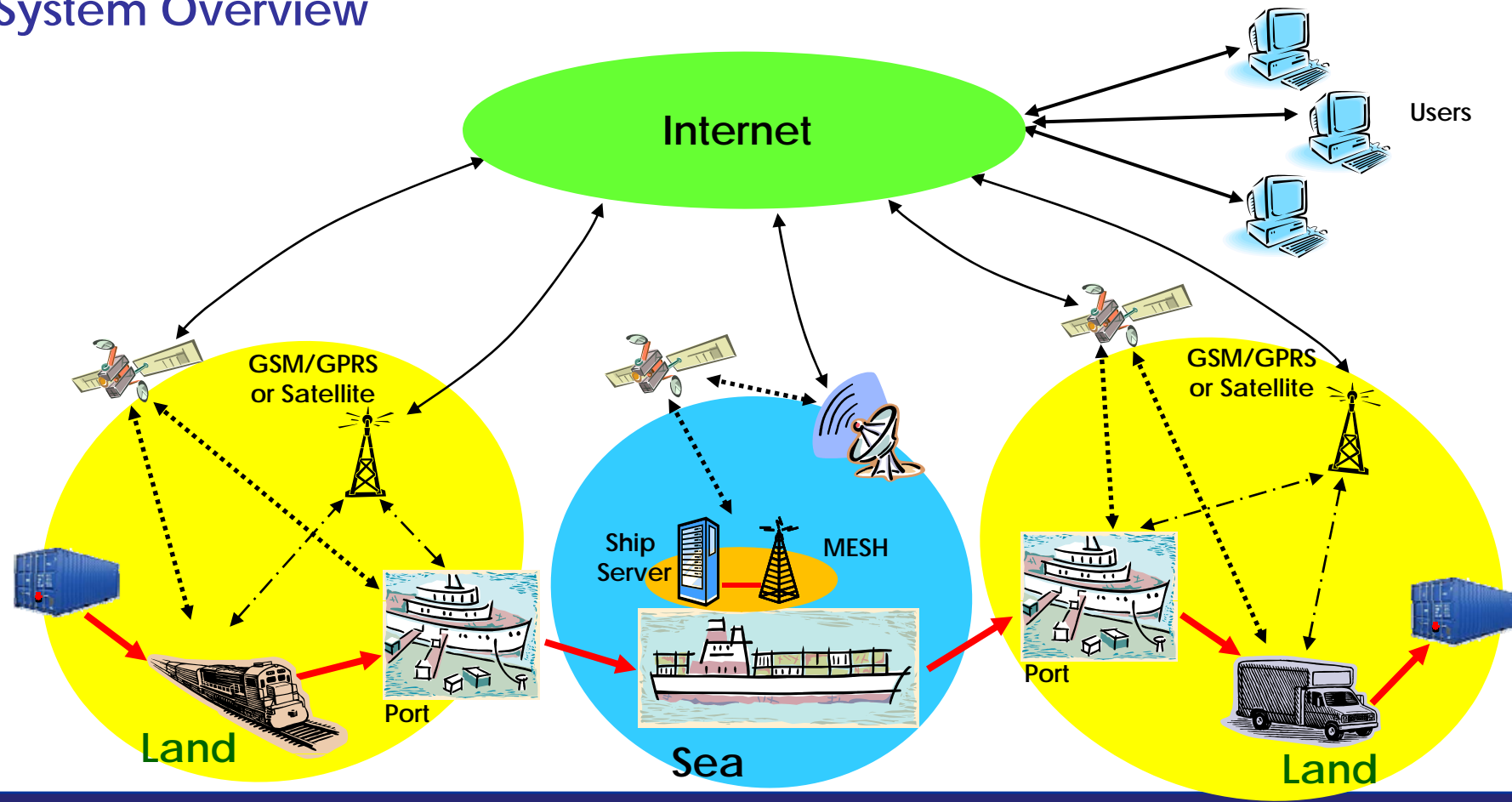
The project will highlight the importance of the container shipping industry to the global economy and the role it plays in the modern world. Container shipping is how almost all of the everyday products and foods that we take for granted, from computers to clothing, bananas to beers and TVs to trainers are made available and affordable. The project provides a live demonstration that container shipping is a truly global industry connecting countries, markets, businesses and people allowing them to operate on the global scale, previously not possible.

Those interested will be able to interactively track the progress of the container on-line through daily GPS tracking updates.
